Description of project

Refurbishment of existing office building to for the Police Learning and Development Centre on a former nuclear power station site. The 3,000 square metre building houses an IT suite, lecture theatre, classrooms and a fitness centre. There project includes external landscape upgrades and a new parade ground.
